It's important to ask the following questions when hiring a tree care professional:

- 1. Are you an ISA Certified Arborist?
- 2. Are you an ISA Qualified Tree Risk Assessor?
- 3. Are you a Qualified Registered Professional Forester?
- 4. Do you have a Port Moody Business License?
- 5. Do you have liability insurance?
- 6. Do you have Errors and Omissions Insurance (recommended for Consulting Arborists)
- 7. Have you done work in Port Moody before?
- 8. What is your experience doing this work?
- 9. Are you familiar with Port Moody's Tree Protection Bylaw?

- It is the responsibility of property owners, property managers, property occupiers, and any contractors they hire, to ensure that they comply with the City's Tree Protection Bylaw No. 2961.
